Nature conservation (Woodland 30% and husbandry 70%). Private landowner.

Main land uses and ownership status of the project area:

Bråxvik nature reserve contains both very old coniferous forest and wet coastal meadows. The oldgrowth forest contain several rare insects, fungus, mosses and lichens. The meadows are breeding sites for waders such as common snipe, redshank and lapwing. During migration an additional number of waders, goose and cranes are using the site for resting.

Scientific description of project area:

The coastal meadows of Bråxvik is one of the larger areas of grazed wetlands along the Baltic coastline of Östergötland. It is important for resting and breeding waders but is not in level with Svensksundsviken.

The site is pointed out as "national interest for nature conservation".

The project will address threats from overgrowing of grassland habitats and grazed forests by measures included in action C1, targeting 36.1 ha.
