Main land uses and ownership status of the project area:

Herrborum is a large manor at the coastline in the inner part of Sant Anna achipelago. In the nature reserve plenty of ancient oaktrees grow and also old coniferous forests as well as wooded pastures. The old trees are rich in rare insects and cryptogams and this is one of the more important sites for the hermit beetle in Sankt Anna.

Close to the manor centre open grasslands with herbich drier parts and wet coastal meadows are situated.

The area has been managed by Count Magnus Stenbock, who didnt want to kill trees at his land why the grazelands at some places has grown over.

Scientific description of project area:

The site is one of the most important for conservation of flora and fauna in and at ancient oaktrees and old wooded pastures in the Archipelago. There are however problems with overgrowth as a result of a long time of poor grazing. The site is pointed out as "national interest for nature conservation".

The project will adress threats from overgrowing of grassland habitats and grazed forests by measures included in action C1, targeting 46.9 ha.

Habitats that will be improved by action C1:

1630: 2,2 ha

6270: 2,1 ha

9070: 30,6 ha

Other grassland: 1,6 ha

Other wooded habitats: 10,4 ha

The understanding of conservation issues related to Natura 2000 and accessibility for visitors will also increase by actions E2 and E4.
