Main land uses and ownership status of the project area:

Dannskären is situated in the outer part of the archipelago of Gryt in the south of Östergötland. Dannskären is one group of small islets. Dannskären is a birdskerry with a very rich birdlife. The bedrock of gneiss is open and flat. Vegetation is only found in the small soilfilled crevices. Allium schoenoprasum, Matricaria inodora v. maritima, Sedum acre, Sedum maximum and Viola tricolor are exampels of the flora of Dannskären. The Caspian Tern has a large colony here.

Scientific description of project area:

Dannskären is a very valueable birdskerry with a rich and varied birdlife. Here is the only colony of Caspian Tern in Östergötland and here are a lot of other seabirds breeding. The flora and the geology is characteristic for the outer part of the archipelago. The archipelago along the eastcoast of Sweden is very valueable in an international perspective. The site is pointed out as of National Interest for Nature conservation.

Threats from predation of Mustela vison on bird colonies will be managed by measures in action C4.
