Main land uses and ownership status of the project area:

The natura 2000 area Figeholm consists primarily of hardwood forest and conifer-dominated mixed forest with a high content of red-listed species and indicator species. Central in the area is an accumulation of old pollarded trees, at least 100. Large trees and lying and standing dead trees are valuable structures in the object. Dense areas with hazel can be found in the object. Here you can see natural forest and deciduous leafy conifer forest with high diversity of species and structures. The value of the object is strengthened by the fact that large areas in recent times have been managed by grazing.

Scientific description of project area:

Updated data about the site in Natura 2000 have been reported to the Swedish Government, and a governmental decision about updates was taken in August 2012. The data in this application are in line with this update.

The site is pointed out as of National Interest for Nature conservation.

The project will address threats from overgrowing of grassland habitats and grazed forests by measures included in action C1, targeting 4.1 ha.

Habitats that will be improved by action C1:

9020: 4.1 ha

Threats against ancient pollard trees will be addressed by action C2. In total 100 trees will be managed.

Habitats that will be improved by action C2:

9020: 3.8 ha

9070: 2.6 ha

Other land: 0.1

Uniform forest stands will be improved by measures in action C7, in total 11.2 ha.

Habitats that will be improved by action C7:

9020: 10.4 ha

9160: 0.8 ha

Wetland will be restored by action C8, targeting 2.2 ha.

Habitats that will be improved by action C8:

7140: 0.5 ha

9080: 0.7 ha

Other land: 1.0 ha

The accessibility for visitors will also increase by action E4.
